



## INFORMATION FOR PUBLIC BUYERS

**PLEASE complete ALL sections of the Public Registration Form, Department of Revenue and DeKalb County Georgia Questionnaire (for DeKalb County Georgia AUCTIONS only)**

**Public Buyers** must complete all forms in order to obtain a BIDDER NUMBER.

**RULES & CONDITIONS OF THE AUCTION:** Anyone wishing to bid on items in the auction must register and obtain a bidder badge. Bid Badge numbers must be visible while at the block bidding. Anyone bidding for an account other than their own must register as such. **Public buyers** bidding on vehicles may pay with a cashier's check, a personal check accompanied by an irrevocable bank letter of guarantee or credit card (VISA, MASTERCARD, and DISCOVER AND DEBIT CARDS WITH A VISA OR MASTERCARD LOGO).

The DeKalb County Board of Commissioners has ordered that its surplus vehicles, equipment and miscellaneous items be sold at ABSOLUTE AUCTION to the highest Bidder.
